As an exhibitor, what can you do to help? Participate in the Donation Program!

Donate items from your booth that could be used by local non-profits.

- Exhibit booth furnishings such as tables, chairs, display cases, etc.
- Promotional items such as pens, pencils, clothing, water bottles, etc.
- Reusable exhibit bags
- Self-contained food items or bottled beverages

Here are a few non-profit organizations we have partnered with:

- Second Chance, Inc. of Baltimore: This organization provides people, materials and the environment with a second chance. Their mission entails deconstructing buildings and homes, and salvaging usable materials that they make available to the public through their retail space. The generated revenue provides job training for those with employment obstacles in the Baltimore region.
- Maryland Food Bank: The Maryland Food Bank is a non-profit hunger-relief organization, leading the
 movement to end hunger throughout Maryland. For more than 35 years, the Maryland Food Bank has
 partnered with communities across the state to distribute food to individuals and families in need
 becoming the leading anti-hunger organization in the state. Through carefully crafted programs, the food
 bank aims to meet the immediate needs of Marylanders while simultaneously working to find long-term
 ways to reduce hunger statewide.
- **Baltimore City Schools:** The Baltimore Convention Center works directly with a variety of Baltimore City Schools whose teachers and students have needs for classroom instructional materials and items.

Just follow the steps below and make an impact!

Step 1: For smaller items, please bring to the donation area next to Exhibitor Services, behind the 1200 aisle. Recycle bins will also be available for any unwanted materials.

Step 2: For larger donations, visit the Freeman service desk for donation stickers and let them know the item(s) you are leaving in your booth along with your booth number. Place stickers on any large item you would like to donate. Leave the item in your booth and a representative will pick it up.
