

**Definition:**

An island exhibit space is 400 square feet or larger with aisles on **all** four sides.  
We do NOT allow peninsula exhibit spaces which are only open on three sides.  
We do NOT allow split island exhibit spaces unless the parent company rents both sides.

**Use of Space:**

An island exhibit space is separated by the width of an aisle from all neighboring exhibits so full use of the exhibit space is permitted.

**Exhibit Space Rental Drape & ID Sign:**

- In-line space will have a standard 8' high red and white back drape and 3' high red side drape.
- Booths 300 square feet or less will receive a 7" x 44" one-line identification sign.

**Carpet:**

Due to COVID 19, in 2021 we will **not** have aisle carpet. Exhibitors will **NOT** be required to carpet their exhibit booth space. If you would like to carpet your exhibit booth space, please see Freeman's rental carpet.

**Height:**

All display fixtures and components including graphics and identification signs are allowed a maximum height of 16 feet. Some venues have low ceiling areas, so please check the service manual for any notices for exhibit spaces located in a low ceiling location.

**All Exhibit Spaces Must Adhere to Display Regulations:**

Including ADA, demonstrations, lighting, sound, structural integrity, and storage.
